Dear Nadine,

I'm writing to apply for the Specialist Paramedic. Urgent Care role within WMAS. I've been a frontline paramedic with the Trust for over four years, covering Birmingham, Solihull, and the Black Country, and I'd like to take the step into the specialist role now that I've completed my Advanced Practice qualification.

On the road, I average 10 emergency calls per 12-hour shift and maintained a 94% patient handover within 15 minutes target over 2024/25, above the trust average of 87%. I've completed 23 successful RSI-assisted intubations since gaining advanced airway competency, and I'm currently mentoring 4 newly qualified paramedics through their first 750 hours. Last year I was seconded to the mental health co-response vehicle in Birmingham city centre, where I attended 340+ crisis calls and helped reduce Section 136 detentions in the area by 28%. I also contributed to the falls response pathway pilot that safely discharged 62% of elderly falls patients at scene.

The specialist urgent care role is the logical next step for me. It combines the autonomous clinical decision-making I've developed with a focus on see-and-treat and referral pathways that keep people out of A&E when they don't need to be there. I hold HCPC registration, MIMMS, and the Pre-Hospital Emergency Medicine advanced practice qualification. Happy to discuss further whenever convenient.
