Dear Duncan,

I'm writing about the Clinical Pharmacist position at Well Pharmacy's Deansgate branch. I've been the lead pharmacist at the Boots Piccadilly flagship for the past two years. One of the highest-volume pharmacies in the North West, dispensing 3,500+ items a week, and I'm interested in moving to a role where clinical services and patient relationships are the main focus rather than retail footfall.

At Boots, I run the travel vaccination clinic I set up from scratch, which generated £48,000 in revenue in its first year through 1,200+ vaccinations including yellow fever, hepatitis A/B, and typhoid. I manage the repeat prescription service for 800+ patients across 14 GP surgeries, supervise 3 dispensing technicians, and maintain a dispensing error rate below 0.02%. I qualified as an independent prescriber in 2024, and before Boots I completed a two-year rotational programme at Manchester University NHS Foundation Trust covering cardiology, respiratory, oncology, and antimicrobials.

What draws me to Well Pharmacy is the emphasis on community clinical services. Pharmacy First, health checks, vaccination programmes. Which is where pharmacy is heading and where I want to focus my career. I'd welcome a conversation about the role whenever suits you.
